The Issue.

Apparel makers in third-world nations are frequently handled harshly and uncaringly by major apparel labels.

• Employees generally labor in dangerous structures with little ventilation, breathing in toxic substances and inhaling fiber dust or blasting sand in unsafe buildings. On textile manufacturing facilities, accidents, fires, injuries, and illness are all too often.



How Does Ethikal Work?

- Ethikal is a consumer-facing app that links customers with companies who emphasize the health and safety of their employees or have taken the required steps to ensure that their employees are well-cared for and not working in hazardous situations.
- Ethikal provides clients with background information about clothing brands, including ratings of manufacturing conditions and whether worker health and safety are a priority and in good standing.
